Annual Report (July 2019-June 2020)

INTRODUCTION: Entrepreneurship Knowledge Cell, PUC was established in July 2019. A committee was constituted that consist of the following members:

Since its establishment, the Entrepreneurship Knowledge Cell was engaged in infrastructural development as well as in organising awareness programs among the students of the college. The Cell received a one-time grant of Rs. 8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs) from Planning and Programme Implementation Department (EDS-MEDMOC) for infrastructural development. There is a designated classroom for the purpose of training on entrepreneurship development and an office room was also created especially for the cell.

ACTIVITIES

Details of Prog. conducted including inauguration, resource persons etc., no. of attendees, reading materials provided, feedback of the prog., etc.

Two general entrepreneurship awareness programs had been organised by EKC, PUC. The first program was held in collaboration with Department of History and Department of Political Science. All the students from these departments, numbering about 300 participated in the program. It was held in Golden Jubilee Hall, Pachhunga University College on 7th February, 2020. It was chaired by Prof. L. H. Chhuanawma, Chairman, Entrepreneurship Knowledge Cell, PUC. Mr. Lalhruaitluanga, Asst. Professor, Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College, Aizawl, Master Trainer, MEDMOC was invited as Resource Person. Dr. Daniel Lalawmpuia, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Economics, PUC also gave a special talk on available financial assistance. After the presentation, discussion followed and many students put forward their queries and it was responded by the Resource Persons.

The second program was held on 13th March, 2020 at the Seminar Hall, PUC, in collaboration with Department of Philosophy, Sociology, Education, Mizo and Psychology. The 6th semester students of these departments attended the

program. It was chaired by Dr. Rohmingmawii, Secretary, Entrepreneurship Knowledge Cell. Dr. Samuel V. L. Thlanga, Associate Professor, Govt. Aizawl West College, Master Trainer, MEDMOC was invited as Resource Person and Dr. Vanramhlimpuii, Director, Zonu Meat Processing Pvt. Ltd. was invited to give a talk on her success story. The presentation was followed by question and answers.

Since it was a general awareness program, reading material was not provided to the attendees.

The Entrepreneurship Knowledge Cell, PUC prepared a form to be filled up by interested students who want to know more about Entrepreneurship and who want to participate in further training. Many students filled up the form and returned to the Teachers-in-charge.
