Vision & Mission of Red Ribbon Club:

Peer Educators:

Role of Peer Educators:

- Receive training on Life Skills, Promotion of Blood Donation and HIV/AIDS Awareness.
- Disseminate information regarding Blood donation and HIV/AIDS to peers.
- Producing innovative BCC (Behavior Change Communication) materials- slogans, jingles, posters, logos, handbill messages, songs and playsetc.
- Encourage group discussions, debates etc. to heighten HIV/AIDS Awareness and treatment support within the campus
- Provide a feedback mechanism for member students to contribute ideas and opinions about Blood donation and HIV/AIDS.

- No. of Regular blood donor — 30 approx.


Nodal Officers:

Two Nodal Officers - Lalsangkimi Sailo and Emily F. Lalnunpuii, Department of Philosophy welcomed these valuable visitors and have a lively interaction.

The Red Ribbon Club of Pachhunga University College put a wall painting on HIV/AIDS awareness near the College Seminar Hall in the previous year.
