Major activities:

- 1. Membership Drive: Since the Club was newly formed, we started the membership drive from 23rd August, it now has three hundred and sixty members (360).
- 2. Observation of World Suicide Prevention Day: The Green Ribbon Club, Pachhunga University College in collaboration with the Dept. of Psychiatry, Kulikawn Hospital organized a programme on the World Suicide Prevention Day at the Multipurpose Auditorium, PUC. The programme was sponsored by National AYUSH Mission and Lawma Enfield (Sikulpuikawn). The two sponsors have given Rs. 25,000 each. Students from Arts, Commerce and BBA participated. The programme comprised of pamphlets distribution, a speech from Dr. C. Lalhrekima (Head, Department of Psychiatry, Kulikawn Hospital) and pledge taking from all the participants.
- 3. Observation of the World Mental Health Day: It was decided that World Mental Health Week be observed wherein the Club had the following activities;

On 7th October, the first programme on account of the World Mental Health Day was organized where a training for Peer Educators of the Green Ribbon Club was done with the resource persons being from VOLCOMH.

On 9th October, a free mental health check-up was done in the campus. For this, stalls were set up near the ege gate, one hundred and eighty (180) students and staffs had their mental health checked up.

On 10th October, which was the actual day of the World Mental Health Day, Lifeskills Training was provided by the committee members to the students of the three government schools (primary, middle & high school) within College veng locality, this programme was sponsored by SEL Foundation, Chanmari.
