BLOOD DONATION CAMP 2022

On 7th (Monday) and 9th (Wednesday) March 2022, NSS PUC Unit organised Blood Donation Camp in the college campus. Doctors and staff from Aizawl Civil Hospital, Aizawl arrived around 10:00 a.m and the donation started. A short function was held to inaugurate the Camp where the Principal gave a speech appreciating the volunteers for their continued efforts in donating their precious blood for people who are unknown to them. The Kick Off of the college Art Club and Sport Club was held in this function. The State NSS Officer Dr. Zirlianngura, who had graced this occasion, gave a short speech where he thanked the efforts and contribution of the volunteers and encouraged them to continue their valuable work for the service of others. He also donated blood on this day. A total of 76 units of blood – 61 males and 15 females – were donated on 7th March.









The second day of the Blood Donation Camp was held on 9th March 2022. A large number of volunteers turned up on this day and a total of 150 units of blood – 52 females and 98 males – were donated.
